

- Persistent fever
- Deteriorated general condition
- Vomiting or diarrhoea





Adults FOR EXAMPLE

- Respiratory difficulty
- Chest pain
- Fainting or paralysis
- Significant loss of blood



Children aged 0 - 16 **FOR EXAMPLE**

- Respiratory difficulty
- Convulsion or fainting
- Significant loss of blood Vomiting or diarrhoea
- with dehydration
- Fever (0 3 months)
- Fracture
